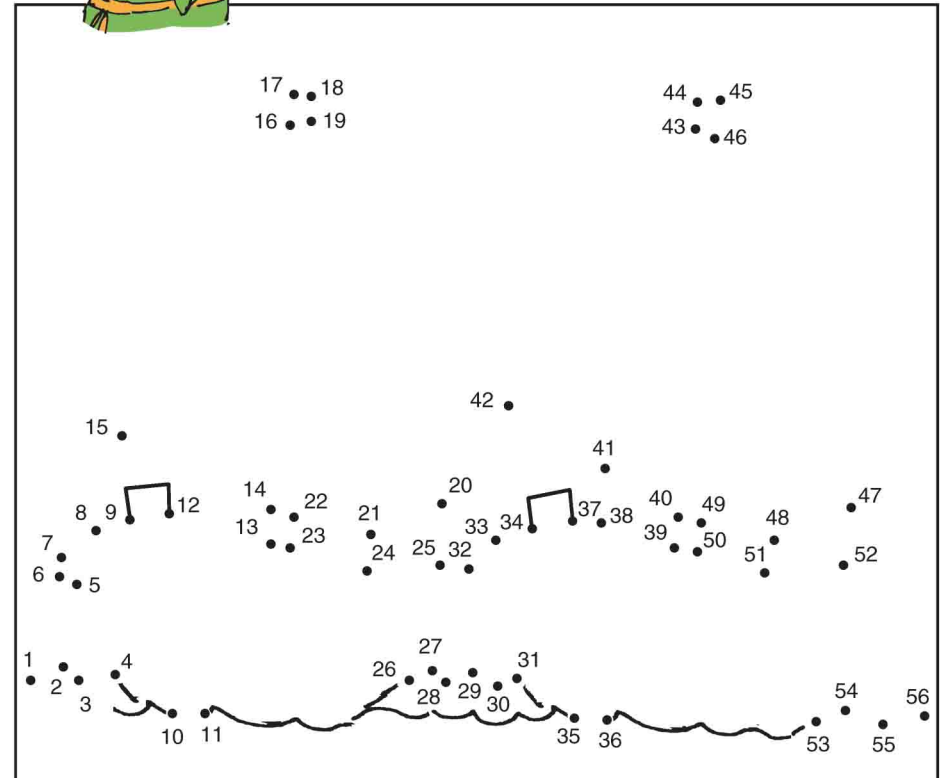

But no one could persuade Paul to stay away from Jerusalem.

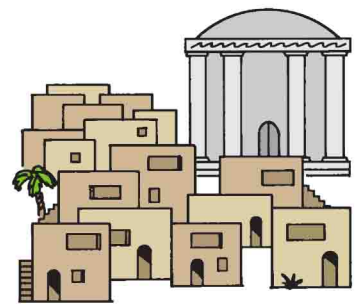
