





She is passionate about ministering to college students, bread-making, and bike riding, and is married to Zach.

#### VIRTUAL COMMUNION TODAY

### 2021 STEWARDSHIP AND BUDGET UPDATE

To date, we have received roughly \$133,000 in pledges from approximately 26 giving units for 2021. This marks a more than 50% decline from 2020, when we received \$280,000 in pledges from 43 giving units. Thanks to the generosity and stewardship of our leaders in years past, the church's balance sheet is able to absorb this deficit for next year. However, if the decline in giving becomes permanent, we would likely be looking at some difficult decisions regarding our staffing and mission support in the near future.
